



The EAA will hold a public seminar on tips to become a smart purchaser of first-hand residential properties

(19 August 2015) To better equip the public with knowledge of property transactions and the important points-to-note when using the services of estate agents, the Estate Agents Authority (“EAA”) will organise a series of public seminars. The first seminar will focus on first-hand residential property transactions and is titled “Tips to become a smart purchaser of first-hand residential properties”. It will be held on 5 September 2015.

Information, such as analysis of the primary residential market, points-to-note when purchasing first-hand residential properties, tips when visiting show flats, and important reminders when purchasing new flats through an estate agent, will be shared at the seminar. “Through this two hour seminar, we aim to enrich the publics’ knowledge of purchasing first-hand residential properties, while at the same time increase their awareness on how to protect their own interests”, Ms Ruby Hon Yuen-ping, Chief Executive Officer of the EAA, said. Ms Hon will deliver the opening remarks at the seminar.

A number of renowned speakers, including Dr Chan Yan-chong, Sr Nelson S. L. Ho, Mr Horace Cheung Kwok-kwan, JP, and Mr Chan U-keng, will share their insights with the audience at the seminar. Former TV news anchor, Ms Akina Fong, will host the seminar.
