



Estate Agents Authority fully supports LegCo election

(23 October 2025) The Estate Agents Authority (“EAA”) echoes the call of the Chief Executive and the Chairman of the Electoral Affairs Commission, fully supporting the upcoming Legislative Council general election. The EAA also calls on the estate agency trade to actively cast their votes on the voting day, fulfilling their civic responsibilities.

On behalf of the EAA, the EAA’s Chairman Professor Simon SIU Chak-yu, BBS, JP and Chief Executive Officer Mr Gordon LEUNG Chung-tai today attended the kick-off ceremony for the 2025 Legislative Council election held by the HKSAR Government and the Electoral Affairs Commission, and called on the estate agency trade to respond in unison.

Professor SIU stated: “The Legislative Council plays an important role in Hong Kong’s political system, electing capable Members to serve on the Council to contribute to Hong Kong’s long-term development is of vital importance. Voting is a both a civic right and a civic duty. The EAA urges all estate agency companies to actively encourage and support their employees to vote, to build a better future together.”

The EAA will make every effort to encourage its staff to vote, while also calling on all estate agency companies to implement flexible work arrangements and facilitative measures on the election day, 7 December 2025 (Sunday), to enable their employees to cast their votes at the polling stations.

The EAA will complement the government's promotional efforts and will later distribute election-related information and promotional materials to the trade to assist them in encouraging employees to vote.
