



EAA announces results of Qualifying Examinations

(20 December 2005) The Estate Agents Authority (EAA) today announced the results of the Estate Agents Qualifying Examination held on 10 November 2005. A total of 1,059 candidates sat the examination and 244 candidates passed, representing a pass rate of around 23%. One candidate passed the examination with commendation.

On the same day, 322 candidates took the paper-based Salespersons Qualifying Examination and 124 candidates passed, representing a pass rate of around 39%.

The Estate Agents and paper-based Salespersons Qualifying Examinations usually take place in March, July and November each year. The average pass rate for the three Estate Agents Qualifying Examinations held this year was about 29% and the average pass rate for the three paper-based Salespersons Qualifying Examinations was about 53%. The next Estate Agents and paper-based Salespersons Qualifying Examinations will be held on 23 March 2006.

Candidates who took the Qualifying Examination on 10 November but have not received notification of their results by the end of this week, are advised to contact the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (Tel: 2328 0061 ext. 322).
