



EAA publishes monographs to enhance professional knowledge of estate agency practitioners

(9 November 2006) The Estate Agents Authority (EAA) has updated six monographs covering major issues of estate agency practice and posted them on the EAA website: www.eaa.org.hk/publications.htm.

Two of the monographs – *Interpretation of a Land Search* and *Encumbrances* – have also been published. EAA will publish the remaining four monographs, *Conveyancing*, *Hong Kong Domestic Tenancy*, *Agency Law* and *Mortgages*, in the coming months.

Chief Executive Officer Ms Sandy Chan said, “EAA is committed to enhancing the level of professionalism of estate agency practitioners and promoting continuing professional development. The new monographs are rich in content, covering a range of legal topics and those related to estate agency practice. These publications will be useful not only to existing estate agency practitioners but also anyone who aspires to enter the trade, and examination candidates.”
