



EAA moves to five-day week
but extends weekday business hours

(21 December 2006) In response to Government's five-day week initiative, the Estate Agents Authority (EAA) will implement five-day week from 1 February 2007 but at the same time extend its weekday working hours.

Starting from that day, the weekday business hours of EAA will be from 8:45am to 5:45pm (instead of the current 8:45am to 5:15pm). The EAA office will be closed on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.

EAA will continue to carry out compliance checks at first-sale sites and agency shops after office hours, on weekends and public holidays.

During non-office hours, licensees and members of the public can obtain information about EAA from the EAA website (www.eaa.org.hk). The EAA hotline (2111 2777) will also continue to operate on a 24-hour basis, providing information on licensing, qualifying examinations, estate agency practice, Continuing Professional Development Scheme and other EAA-related matters.
