<u>Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations Sanctions</u> (Central African Republic) Regulation 2020 on CEDB's website

On 22 February 2021 (New York Time), the Committee of the United Nations Security Council ("UNSC") established pursuant to UNSC Resolution 2127 concerning the Central African Republic ("the Committee") amended the entry of one individual to the list of individuals and entities subject to sanctions under the sanctions regime for the Central African Republic. Please refer to the <u>press releases</u> for details.

Pursuant to section 33 of the United Nations Sanctions (Central African Republic) Regulation 2020 (Cap.537CM) ("CAR Regulation"), an updated list of individuals and entities is published on CEDB's <u>website</u> at 11:00 am on 23 February 2021. Section 6 of the CAR Regulation prohibits the making available of economic assets to or for the benefit of persons and entities on the list; as well as dealing with any economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by such persons or entities.
