The EAA Board Appoints the Chairmen of Standing Committees

(16 November 2021) The Board of the Estate Agents Authority ("EAA") held its meeting today and appointed the chairmen of its five standing committees, which oversee different aspects of the EAA's work respectively.

The EAA Board is the highest decision-making authority of the EAA. It sets the EAA's overall strategic direction and policies, as well as supervises and monitors the performance of the EAA Administration. Chaired by Ms Elaine LIU, JP, the EAA Board currently has 20 members including the Chairman, Vice-chairman and 18 ordinary members. They were all appointed by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and, among them, two members were newly on board this month. The EAA Board members come from varied backgrounds with diverse knowledge, experience and expertise, including the sectors of real estate agency, property development, business, legal, finance, regulatory and academia.
