## <u>Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations</u> Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 on CEDB's website

On 28 February 2022 (New York Time), the United Nations Security Council ("UNSC") adopted Resolution 2624. According to paragraph 5 of the Resolution, the UNSC decided that **one entity** listed in the annex of this resolution shall be subject to the measures imposed by paragraph 14 (viz. targeted arms embargo) of resolution 2216 (2015). Please refer to the Resolution 2624 for details. No separate press release was issued by UN regarding the above amendment up to this moment.

Pursuant to section 30 of the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Cap.537CI), an updated list of individuals and entities is published on CEDB's website at 3:00 pm on 3 March 2022. Sections 2 and 3 of the Yemen Regulation prohibit the supply, sale, transfer and carriage of prohibited goods (i.e. arms or related materiel) to individuals and entities on the list as well as those acting on behalf of or acting at the direction of such individuals and entities. Section 4 of the Yemen Regulation prohibits the provision of any assistance related to military activities or the provision, maintenance or use of any arms or related materiel to individuals and entities on the list as well as those acting on behalf of or acting at the direction of such individuals and entities.
