EAA offices to reopen to the public

(6 April 2022) In view of the latest developments of the COVID-19 epidemic, the Estate Agents Authority (“EAA”) today announced that the EAA offices will reopen to the public with effect from 11 April 2022 (next Monday).

However, in order to reduce crowd gatherings and the chances of virus transmission, the EAA counters will only provide services to licence applicants who have made a prior appointment through the EAA’s online booking system.
