<u>Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations</u> <u>Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 on CEDB's website</u>

On 27 September 2022 (New York Time), the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 2140 concerning Yemen **added two individuals** to its sanction list. Please refer to the <u>press release</u> for detail.

Pursuant to section 30 and 31 of the United Nations Sanctions (Yemen) Regulation 2019 (Cap.537CI), an updated list of individuals and entities was published on CEDB's website at 11:00 am on 28 September 2022. Sections 2 and 3 of the Yemen Regulation prohibit the supply, sale, transfer and carriage of prohibited goods (i.e. arms or related materiel) to individuals and entities on the list as well as those acting on behalf of or acting at the direction of such individuals and entities. Section 4 of the Yemen Regulation prohibits the provision of any assistance related to military activities or the provision, maintenance or use of any arms or related materiel to individuals and entities on the list as well as those acting on behalf of or acting at the direction of such individuals and entities. Section 5 of the Yemen Regulation prohibits the making available of any economic assets to or for the benefit of individuals and entities on the list, or dealing with any economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by such individuals and entities.
