<u>Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations</u> <u>Sanctions (ISIL and Al-Qaida) Regulation on CEDB's website</u>

On 14 November 2023 (New York Time), the Committee of the United Nations Security Council ("UNSC") established pursuant to UNSC Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida ("the Committee") **amended the details of 5 entries (4 individuals and 1 entity)** on its sanction list which was available on the UNSC's website on 15 November 2023 (New York Time). Please refer to the **press releases** for details.

Pursuant to section 25 of the United Nations Sanctions (ISIL and Al-Qaida) Regulation (Cap. 537 CB) ("the Regulation"), an updated list of individuals and entities was published on CEDB's website at 11:00 a.m. on 16 November 2023. Sections 2 and 3 of the Regulation prohibit the supply, sale, transfer or carriage of arms or related materiel to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities. Section 4 of the Regulation prohibits the provision of any assistance related to military activities to, or for the benefit of, certain persons or entities. Section 5 of the Regulation prohibits the making available of economic assets to or for the benefit of persons and entities on the list; as well as dealing with any economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by such persons or entities.
