

Publication of list of individuals and entities under the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) Regulation 2019 on CEDB's website

On 17 October 2023 (New York Time), the United Nations Security Council (“UNSC”) published a press release, announcing that the Committee of the UNSC established pursuant to UNSC Resolutions 1970 concerning Libya–approved on 16 October 2023 **the delisting of one individual from travel ban measure**, hence invoking an amendment of the descriptions of that individual on its sanctions list. Pursuant to section 43 of the United Nations Sanctions (Libya) Regulation 2019 (Cap.537CF) ("Libya Regulation"), an updated list of individuals and entities was published on CEDB's [website](#) today. Section 9 of the Libya Regulation, which continues to be applicable to the individual listed above, amongst others, prohibits the making available of economic assets to or for the benefit of persons and entities on the list; as well as dealing with any economic assets belonging to, or owned or controlled by such persons or entities.
